

ORGANIZE YOUR VISIT TO VENICE STRAIGHT FROM THE CAMPING SITE!

How to get to Venice

From the Punta Sabbioni pier (few kms away far from the camping facilities), you can **take a motorboat to Venice every half an hour**. The journey takes about 40 minutes, during which you can admire the Giardini della Biennale, the St. Mark's basin, the St. Giorgio Maggiore Island to your left, finally reaching St. Mark's Square.

3 FREE HOURS?

Once at St. Mark's Square, **visit the Doge's Palace**. A masterpiece of Gothic Architecture, the Palace is a layer-upon-layer gathering of building foundation and ornamentations, comprised its original structure and significant Renaissance and opulent Mannerist details. Lasting about one hour, the visit starts with the stunning Courtyard, followed by the magnificent rooms of the Doge's Apartment, the Armoury, and the Prisons.

5 FREE HOURS?

Once you have visited Doge's Palace, take your time to **appreciate the other museums at St. Mark's Square included in your ticket**. The **Museo Correr** suggests a different, fascinating insight into the art and history of Venice and, comprised in the itinerary, you can also visit the **Museo Archeologico Nazionale** and the **Monumental Rooms of the Biblioteca Nazionale Marciana** collections.

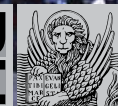

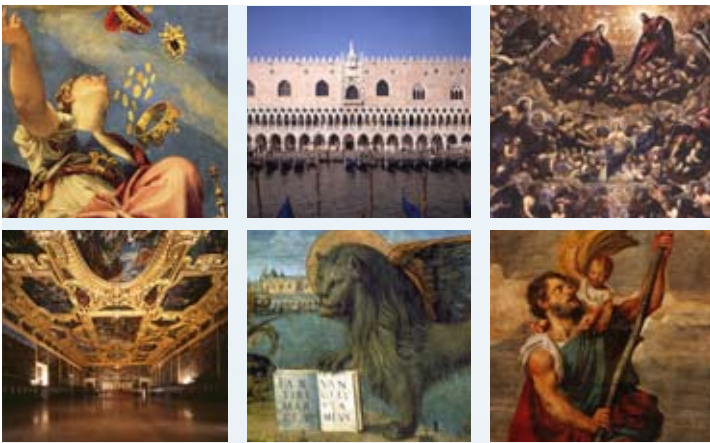

1. Doge's Palace

Venice's symbol. For 800 years and through various stages of its development, the Palace was the Doges' residence and home to the State Courts. Several historic periods are represented in this extraordinary structure of elements and ornamentations; from its original foundations to the magnificent Gothic complex and great interiors superbly decorated by masters such as Titian, Veronese, Tiepolo, and Tintoretto.

Opening hours: 8.30 am - 7 pm

2. Museo Correr

Museo Correr offers various visit itineraries: from the Neoclassical rooms, with masterpieces by Antonio Canova, to the historical collections on the city's institutions, urban history and daily life. The picture gallery, one of the richest and most fascinating collections of Venetian painting from its origins to the early 16th century, includes works by Lorenzo Veneziano, the Bellini family, Carpaccio, and Cosmè Tura.
